

Deer Splitter Tips and Information

- Warning! Keep fingers away from blade at all times!
- Blade is made from 420 Stainless Steel (like a gun barrel), so it may have “flash” rust from time to time – simply wipe with light oil or similar to remove
- Best results are achieved when hide/skin is cut with your knife before cutting sternum and pelvic bone
- If you need to sharpen blade, it can be done with a file without disassembling the product (it doesn't have to be razor sharp!)
- Use only for cutting game animals.
- Cleanup is easy – rinse off or use soapy water
- Cutting the pelvic bone on a large animal (over 200#) may take some “can-opener” type working of the blade as the bone tends to try to snap back together. Some users have recommended making 2 cuts parallel to one another as this tends to give you more operating room.
